**SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:** In addition to the Scholarship Application, applicants must provide the following:

- 1. Two letters of recommendation from faculty members must be submitted one of which must be from a current faculty member of York College.
- 2. Official college transcript The Association will get this from the Registrar.
- 3. Biographical Sketch
- 4. Future plans essay of approximately 300 words.
- 5. Photo- Head shot only, passport size.

Purpose:-Scholarships are awarded for recognition of academic achievement, community service and extracurricular activities.

Awards:-The Scholarship awards will be presented at the York College Alumni's Annual Graduates' Reception to be held in May.

Selection Process:-The York College Alumni Scholarships and Awards Committee will interview selected candidates at an appointed date and time. Selections will be based on candidates who best demonstrate tangible examples of his/her commitment to academic advancement, community service and extracurricular activities.

Award Amount: Each Full-Time scholarship is \$2,000.00 for the school year beginning in the Fall.

Only one (1) scholarship will be awarded in each of the four areas.

PLEASE NOTE THAT INCOMPLETE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKETS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM CONSIDERATION.

All Scholarship monies are paid to the recipients' University accounts.

## SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTIONS

- 1. Gilbert T. Boozer Memorial Freshman Scholarship: The Gilbert T. Boozer Memorial Scholarship is given to a freshman that has completed a minimum of 12 and not more than 29.9 credits and has maintained a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better. In addition, participates in community service projects and/or is actively involved in a York College club or activity.
- 2. John B.K. Aheto Scholarship for sophomores: The John B.K. Aheto Scholarship is given to a sophomore who has completed a <u>minimum of 30 credits and not more than 59.9</u> credits and has maintained a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better. In addition, participates in community service projects and/or is actively involved in a York College club or activity.
- 3. York College Alumni, Inc. Scholarship for Juniors: The York College Alumni Scholarship is given to a junior who has completed a <u>minimum of 60 credits and not more than 89.9 credits</u> and has maintained a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better. In addition, participates in community service projects and/or is actively involved in a York College club or activity.
- 4. Mark Green Athletic Scholarship for Academic Achievement: The Mark Green Athletic Scholarship for Academic Achievement is given to an individual of any York College athletic team who has completed a <u>minimum of 12 credits</u> and has maintained a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better.

For the purpose of these Scholarships, community service is defined, as service to the community for which there is no remuneration. Participation in a college club activity can replace the community service component of the scholarship.

\* Activities cannot be a part of class assignments.
