



100 Hispanic Women Graduate Fellowship 2016/2017 Scholarship Program

The **100 Hispanic Women Graduate Fellowship (100HWGF)** was created to provide eligible candidates an annual tuition scholarship award up to \$2,500, paid directly to the college or university, throughout the tenure of their Masters or Doctoral Degree Program. Established in 2014, the **100HWGF** supports its scholars to succeed in their academic and professional lives, to create social change, and to become active leaders in their communities and fields of study.

The **100HWGF** provides financial support to recipients, as well as educational programs and activities over the tenure of their graduate and postgraduate programs. 100 Hispanic Women National, Inc. seeks young Latinas with outstanding academic and literary attainments, and who demonstrate outstanding character, leadership, and dedication to service.

100HWGF Scholarship Program Criteria:

To apply to the **100HWGF**, you must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Latina student enrolled in an eligible college/university Masters or Doctoral Degree Program (6 credits or more);
- U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident;
- Cumulative undergraduate or graduate GPA of 3.0 or higher;
- Recent completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher throughout graduate/post graduate program;
- Official transcripts submitted two (2) times each year (Fall & Spring Semesters);
- Demonstrated leadership qualities, active participation in public/community service, and commitment to the missions of 100HW and their enrolled college/university; and
- Participate in two (2) annual workshops, annual Award Ceremony, and community service project approved by 100 Hispanic Women National, Inc.

All interested and eligible students are encouraged to apply. Please visit www.100HispanicWomen.org, download and read the **100HWGF** application, and submit the following documents by the deadline below:

- Application Parts 1 & II, Signed Disclosure Agreement, Submission Checklist;
- Current resume;
- Current completed FAFSA;
- Official college or university transcripts for undergraduate, graduate, or postgraduate study;
- Current official college or university enrollment letter; and
- Two (2) letters of recommendation that evaluate demonstrated community service, volunteer and leadership activities.
