SPONSOR SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

A sponsor must show sufficient income and/or financial resources to assure that the student being sponsored will not become a public charge (receive Federal or State low income benefits or services) while in the United States. **The balance of a sponsor's bank statement(s) MUST EQUAL OR EXCEED the annual amount that is being committed to the student.** Evidence should consist of copies of any or all of the following documentation listed below that are applicable to the sponsor's situation. Failure to provide evidence of sufficient income and/or financial resources may result in the denial of the student's application for a visa or his or her removal from the United States. **Financial documents cannot be older than three months.**

- A. Current bank statement or written statement from an officer of the bank or other financial institution or brokerage where the sponsor has accounts, giving the following details regarding the account:
 - 1. Date account opened
 - 2. Total amount deposited for the past year
 - Present balance
- B. Copy of last income tax return filed and W2
- C. Statement of your employer on business stationery showing:
 - 1. Date and nature of employment
 - 2. Salary paid
 - 3. Whether the position is temporary or permanent
- D. If self-employed:
 - 1. Copy of last income tax return filed or
 - 2. Report of commercial rating concern
 - 3. Schedule of assets with supporting documents
