INSTRUCTION FOR PERMISSION TO TAKE COURSE(S) AT A NON-CUNY INSTITUTION

York College students who wish to take a courses at another institution, outside of the City University of New York, MUST obtain prior permission from York College in order to receive credits toward their degree. The following will answer some questions about “permits” and explain how to obtain a permit.

- **When can I file for a Non-CUNY Permit?**

Students registering at York College for the specified semester and/or session MAY request a permit when registration begins. York College will not issue retroactive or late permits.

- **Who is eligible to take courses at a Non-CUNY institution?**

Students who are matriculated, have **completed** one semester of matriculation (Fall or Spring **ONLY**) at York College, have an undergraduate **GPA of 2.00** or higher or a graduate **GPA of 3.00** or higher, and currently attending York College.

- **How do I apply for a Non-CUNY permit?**

Complete this application, have the chairperson of the courses **sign and date the application**. When completed, student **MUST UPLOAD** form along with a **valid PHOTO ID** to the [**Registrar's Secure Portal**](#). Printed out forms **WILL NOT** be accepted in person or through email.

- **What grade do I need to achieve in order to receive credit for my Non-CUNY permit courses?** A student **MUST** obtain a grade of 'C' or better. **Only letter** grades will be accepted for courses fulfilling General Education, Pathways requirements and Major or Minor requirements. 'P' grades **ARE NOT** acceptable to fulfill degree requirement, **ONLY** for free electives.

- **What do I do after I complete the courses?**

In order to have your permit credits posted to your academic record, you **MUST** request the Host college to send an **official transcript** to York College. - **Other Important Information**

Credit Limit

A student's schedule, including courses taken both at York College and on permit, **MAY NOT** exceed the maximum credit load for each semester or session. Students must be registered at York College concurrently for the semester with the permit courses (except during summer or winter sessions).

Course Restriction

Courses taken to fulfill Writing Intensive requirements **MUST** be approved by the **Writing Intensive Coordinator** at York College. Some academic departments may have additional restrictions.
