DO'S



- Know the Rules
 Read and understand your college's
 Academic Integrity Policy. Not
 knowing the rules is not an excuse.
- Paraphrase with Purpose
 Practice paraphrasing source
 material. Visit your college's writing
 center to strengthen this skill.
- Cite Everything
 Whether you quote, summarize, or paraphrase—always give credit to your sources.
- Follow Exam Rules
 Know what is allowed: notes, devices, collaboration—your instructor will let you know.
- Take It Seriously
 Cheating and plagiarism can lead to course failure, suspension, or expulsion. It's not worth the risk.

DON'TS



Don't Misuse Al or Homework Sites

Tools like ChatGPT, Course Hero, and Chegg should not be used to copy or upload coursework.

- Don't Ask Someone to Do Your Work Whether it's a friend or a website, it's considered cheating.
- Don't Copy & Paste
 Without Quoting
 Using a source's exact words
 without quoting is plagiarism—
 even if it's "just a few sentences."
- Don't Let Tools Do the Work for You

 Online paraphrasing or citation generators can help—but they're just guides, not substitutes.
- Don't Reuse Past Work Without Permission

 If you want to reuse your own past work for another class, get permission from both instructors.
